#1 KUTZTOWN GOLDEN BEARS

Quick Hits

- Finishing one win shy of advancing to its first Elite Eight in program history in its fourth-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015-16, Kutztown seeks to make back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for just the second time in school history (2009-10).
- As the defending PSAC East champions, KU is looking to win consecutive Division titles for the first time since winning three in a row from 2007-08 to 2009-10.
- Kutztown won 20+ games for the fifth time in program history in 2015-16. Four of those five seasons have come in the previous nine years.
- Defending PSAC East Athlete of the Year Josh Johnson will attempt to become the first Golden Bear in school history to defend the award. Johnson already has his name all over the KU record book as he ranks in the top-12 in program history in seven career statistical categories. He is currently sixth in rebounds (666), seventh in blocks (94), eighth in field goal percentage (58.8), ninth in field goals made (486), 11th in scoring average (14.1) and 12th in points (1,245) and free throws made (264).
- KU had three players (Johnson, Ryan Connolly, Anthony Lee) earn All-PSAC honors for the second year in a row.
- 2015-16 All-PSAC East Second Teamer Connolly's 67 3-pointers last year were the fourth most by a Golden Bear in single-season history, while his 152 career 3-pointers rank ninth.
- Austin Beidelman currently ranks eighth in program history with 274 career assists.

#3 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

Quick Hits

- ESU (21-7) missed the PSAC Final Four for the first time since 2009 last winter. The Warriors advanced 6 straight years (2010-15), matching California (1992-97) for the most consecutive Final 4's in the last 35 years.
- ESU's 152 wins since the start of the 2010 season rank 2nd in the PSAC and 3rd in the Atlantic Region.
- ESU head coach Jeff Wilson (253-146, 15th season) is 12th in PSAC history in career wins. Wilson has guided ESU to the 2012 and 2014 PSAC championships and is one of 3 current PSAC coaches with multiple conference titles (Joe Lombardi, IUP, 3 and John T. Reilly, Gannon, 2).
- ESU leads DII in turnover margin (+5.30) since the start of the 2012-13 season. The Warriors have ranked in the top 15 in DII in each of the last 4 years.
- ESU has led the PSAC in scoring for 4 straight seasons and set a school record (88.0 ppg) in 2015-16.
- Senior forward Rasheed Moore can become ESU's first 4-time All-PSAC East selection. Moore has 1,155 career points and 578 rebounds, on track for the top 5 in school history in both categories.
- Sophomore Kitt Najee Walls led the PSAC in assists (5.4) last season, ranking 23rd in DII and 3rd among DII freshmen.

#4 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

Quick Hits

- SHIP returns seven players from the 2015-16 team after losing six seniors to graduation. Three of the team's five starters are back - including postseason honorees junior Dustin Sleva and senior Abe Massaley.
- SHIP went 20-9 last season - finishing tied for the second-most wins in school history. The Raiders reached the PSAC Semifinals for the first time since the 2005-2006 season.
- Chris Fite enters his second season guiding the Raiders. Fite, who spent seven seasons as an assistant at IUP, is the 10th head coach in the team's history and just the third in 44 years.
- Dustin Sleva was named to the All-PSAC East First Team and 2016 NABC All-District Second Team after finishing the only player in Division II men's basketball to average at least 15 points and 11 rebounds while having made at least 40 three pointers on the year. He led the Raiders in almost every statistical category, averaging a double-double, scoring 15.8 points per game and grabbing 11.0 rebounds per game.
- Abe Massaley was named to the All-PSAC East Second Team after averaging 13.6 points per game and leading the team in assists with 135. Massaley proved to be a clutch performer in 2015-16, making three game-winning shots with less than three seconds to go during the year. He is 11 points shy of 1,000 for his career.
- Head Coach Chris Fite's team started 5-5 last year but finished 15-4 down the stretch. SU was fifth in the PSAC in rebounding and seventh in scoring.

#5 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

Quick Hits

- The Bloomsburg men's basketball team went 17-10 overall a year ago and 15-7 in the PSAC Eastern Division. The Huskies dropped an 80-78 decision at Shippensburg in the opening round of the PSAC Tournament.
- Last year's 17 victories was the second-highest single-season total for head coach John Sanow, who will be entering his 11th season with the Huskies (118-151 overall). Bloomsburg went 19-9 under Sanow during the 2011-12 campaign. The Huskies' 15-7 mark in conference play last season tied Sanow's 2011-12 squad for the best league record under his direction.
- Redshirt junior Christian Mortellite returns after an All-PSAC East First Team campaign last season. Mortellite led all Eastern Division players, and was fifth overall in the PSAC, by averaging 19.0 points per game last season. He was the only Huskies' player to finish in double figures in scoring last season. Mortellite was also second on the team in rebounding (6.0) and in assists (2.2).
- Mortellite enters the season needing 129 points to become the 29th player in school history to record 1,000 career points. He is also seventh in school history with 117 career three-pointers made.
- Senior point guard Donell Diggs also returns after a solid first season with the Huskies. Diggs led the team with 113 assists (43 turnovers) and was third on the team averaging 9.1 points per game. Diggs led the PSAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.6) last season and was tied for sixth in the league in assists per game (4.3).

- After serving as interim head coach last season, now permanent head coach Pat Zipfel has brought in a class of 10 student athletes including three Division I transfers in Jeremiah Worthem (North Carolina Central), Jahyde Gardiner (Iona), and Malik Carter (Delaware State).
- Mansfield ranked 13th in the PSAC in scoring last season averaging 71.1 points an outing but was last in the conference defensively after allowing 84.1 points a game to opponents.

- The Bald Eagles earned a spot in their third straight PSAC Tournament last season (2015-16) after going 8-14 in PSAC play which earned them the sixth-seed out of the Eastern Division. When LHU qualified for the postseason in 2013-14, it marked Lock Haven's first playoff appearance since 2003.
- LHU will have two starters returning from last season. Brahieme Jackson had a stellar season last year and hopes to continue that this season. He averaged 11.1 points per game while grabbing 6.9 rebounds per game. Cole Renninger appeared in all 27 games while dishing out an average of 1.9 assists per game.
- Lock Haven will also look to Ra'eese Hunt, and Craig Slade who both appeared in 26 games each. Hunt averaged 9.8 points per game.
- The Bald Eagles are also very excited to introduce five freshmen to the team. All five student athletes are from Pennsylvania including Jakwon McQueen who will add height by standing at 6-6.
- The Haven will have a young team that will feature eight freshman/sophomore's out of the 13 players on the roster.
- LHU head coach MikeNestor has taken the men's basketball program to new heights in his six seasons at the helm of the program. Over the last three seasons, LHU has combined to win 39 games.

#1 IUP CRIMSON HAWKS

Quick Hits

- IUP head coach Joe Lombardi returns for his 11th season on the sideline. Lombardi became the program's all-time wins leader with his 207th victory on Nov. 27 against The Sciences (Phila.), and enters this season with a record of 225-85 (.725). In 10 years, he's won six PSAC West Division titles, three conference tournament championships, and has taken the Crimson Hawks to seven NCAA tournaments, including two appearances in the Division II championship game (2010, 2015).
- The Crimson Hawks return six players who started at least one game last year, including four players with 11 or more starts in 2015-16. Jr. G Anthony Glover is the leading returning scorer with 10.0 points per game, and was one of only two players to start all 29 contests a season ago. So. G Dante Lombardi - Coach Lombardi's youngest son - drained 48 3-pointers and was named the PSAC West Freshman of the Year. Also returning is So. F Jacobo Diaz, who led IUP with 6.7 rebounds per game and made 48.0 of his field goal attempts.
- Making a return is R-Sr. F Devon Cottrell, who missed all but six games last year due to injury. Cottrell is second all-time in program history with 151 career blocks, trailing former National Player of the Year Darryl Webb's (2007-11) 162 career swats.
- One newcomer looking to make an impact is R-Jr. F Blake Danielak, who redshirted last year after transferring from Drake. Two transfers who are in their first year at IUP include Jr. G Ayron Hutton (Quinnipiac) and So. G Jesse Huff (Lackawanna).
