#1 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

Quick Hits

- SHIP returns 13 players from the 2015-16 team, including all five starters for the second consecutive year. Of the 13 returners, seven are seniors: not only all five starters, but also forward Haley Scullion (who started 21 games last season in Knauer's absence), and second-year transfer guard Chanice Lee.
- SHIP will welcome three newcomers to the team, all freshmen: forward Shavonna Waters (Harrisburg), forward Lindsay Embly (Chambersburg) and guard/forward Ashley Stone (Susquehannock).
- Senior Morgan Griffith returns after a sensational third season with the Raiders. Griffith garnered several postseason awards, including PSAC East Player of the Year, CCA All-Atlantic Region Women's Basketball Second Team, and Honorable Mention on the WBCA All-American Team.
- Senior Lauren Gold is the first player in PSAC history to have multiple seasons with a free-throw percentage of 90 percent or better. Gold broke her own school record last season, finishing at 90.5 percent (124-of-137). As a sophomore, she shot 90.0 percent (153-of-170). She enters 2016-17 just 26 points shy of 1,000 for her career.
- SHIP was ranked near the top of the PSAC for most prominent offensive statistical categories for the 2015-16 season. SU ranked third in the conference in scoring, averaging 71.4 points per game, and posted the third-best scoring margin of 7.8 points per game. SHIP led the conference in field-goal percentage.

#2 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

Quick Hits

- ESU head coach Diane Decker was named PSAC East Coach of the Year in her first year in charge after guiding the Warriors to a 15-13 record, including a 14-6 mark in the season's final 20 games. She led ESU to the PSAC postseason tournament for a fourth-straight year.
- Senior forward Allison Howard is one of two returning starters, along with senior guard Rachel Falkowski. Howard became the sixth ESU player to earn first-team All-PSAC East honors since 2000 last winter. She averaged a career-high 15.5 points and 7.8 rebounds per game while shooting 37.1 percent from 3-point range. Howard scored in double figures in 23 of 28 games and finished with eight double-doubles.
- Junior guard Imani Brown also averaged in double-figures, contributing 12.1 points per game off the bench. Brown led the team in scoring 10 times, including each of the final three games of the season. She came off the bench in 25 of the 28 games she appeared in, scoring 10+ points 16 times as a reserve (18 overall).
- The Warriors led all PSAC schools in blocks per game last season (5.14), with junior center Rebecca Rutkowski topping the conference individually with 2.3 rejections per contest. ESU was also second in 3-point percentage defense (.279) and third in overall FG percentage defense (.375).

#3 MILLERSVILLE MARAUDERS

Quick Hits

- After a one-year hiatus, the Marauders returned to the PSAC Tournament in 2015-16, marking the 22nd postseason appearance under head coach Mary Fleig. Millersville defeated Lock Haven before narrowly falling at Shippensburg (58-56) in the PSAC Quarterfinal.
- Millersville went 19-9 in the 2015-16 campaign, righting the ship after a 1-4 start. Celeste Robinson lead the Marauders in scoring, averaging 13.9 points per game on her way to an All-PSAC East selection. Millersville graduated four seniors in 2016, including Yasmin Cooper who led the team in rebounds with 7.8 a game and Shelby Reimer who led Millersville with 3 assists per game and drained a team-high 56 three-pointers.
- The top returnees for Millersville are Celeste Robinson and Aunjel Van Brakle. In addition to leading the team in scoring, Robinson led the Marauders in field goals, free throws and steals. Robinson's 2.0 steal- per game ranked her fifth in the PSAC and the redshirt junior scored 15 or more points 15 times last season. Robinson scored a season- high 23 points against Goldey-Beacom and averaged 6.7 rebounds per game which ranked her second on the team in that category.
- Van Brakle led Millersville with 32 blocks averaging 1.2 per game. Van Brakle was second on the team in free throws and third in points, rebounds and steals and scored 15 or more points eight times.
- Millersville will look to get big minutes from redshirt freshman Taylor Pritchett and Savanna Krusinsky.

#4 WEST CHESTER GOLDEN RAMS

Quick Hits

- In her first two seasons, head coach Kiera Wooden has had the best start by a coach with a 45-14 record (.763), while also being the first to lead her squad to consecutive national tournament appearances.
- West Chester has reached the NAAs in three of the last five campaigns
- Seven seniors graduated, including Brittany Sicinski (1,624 points) and Dallas Ely (1,607 points) who went down in the record books as West Chester's all-time leading scorers.
- The senior class combined to score 5,975 points in their four years (two of them five) at West Chester. Due to the graduating class, only 16 percent of the offensive production returns.
- The Golden Rams won the PSAC Eastern Division last season for the first time since 2009 and the first time outright since 2004.

#5 KUTZTOWN GOLDEN BEARS

Quick Hits

- Nine of Kutztown's 16 losses in 2015-16 were decided by either two possessions or less, or in overtime.
- Entering 2015-16, KU had just one senior and two players that averaged more than 11 minutes back from 2014-15. Entering this season, the Golden Bears have five seniors as well as seven players who averaged more than 11 minutes last year.
- Last season, Kutztown had two players, Kelsey Watson and Natalya Lee, earn All-PSAC honors for the first time since 2010-11.
- Jenna Altomare made a 3-pointer in all 26 of KU's games last season. She set the school-record for 3-pointers in a season with 87 and enters 2016-17 fifth all-time in program history with 127 made for her career, 64 shy of the school-record of 191.
- 2015-16 All-PSAC East selection Kelsey Watson currently ranks 10th all-time in school history in scoring average (11.7) and blocks (71). Last season, her 16.7 points per game, 435 total points, 169 field goals and 237 total rebounds all ranked in the top-10 for a single-season in school-history.

Quick Hits

- Last season, Lock Haven qualified for the PSAC Tournament making it the second straight year for The Haven. In 2014-15 LHU made it to the PSAC Tournament for the first time in 24 years (1990-91 season).
- LHU will seek guidance from two returning starters Mackenzie Livingston and Lysa Mealing. Last season Livingston averaged 10.5 points per game and just over five rebounds per game. Mealing averaged almost nine points per game while hauling in an astounding 13.7 rebounds per game.
- Mealing's 13.7 rebounds per game not only lead the PSAC it also lead all NCAA DII.
- Lock Haven also returns five players that played in over 25 games last season which will only benefit the team's depth.
- The Bald Eagles also added a talented recruiting class of four freshmen – Rileigh Devin, Becca Reilly, Ali Hillson, and Maimuna Kenneh. LHU also will benefit from one transfer – Kayla Henderson from Lackawanna College. All five players are from Pennsylvania and will be able to immediately help continue the team's success. Kenneh will help with height as she stands at 6-3.

#7 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

Quick Hits

- The Bloomsburg University women's basketball team will have a new head coach in the 2016-17 season as former Mansfield boss, Alison Tagliaferri, takes over. Tagliaferri replaces former head coach, Bill Cleary, who departed after eight seasons for Division I Colgate University.
- Bloomsburg went 13-14 overall and 10-12 in the PSAC Eastern Division a year ago. The sub-.500 record ended a string of six straight winning seasons and six straight seasons of at least 20 victories.
- The Huskies return seven players from last year's roster and will welcome seven newcomers to the squad. The team features only two seniors – Morgan Klunk and Alex Ross – and one junior in transfer Caitlin Conroy. The seven returners combined to average 31.8 points per game last season with three of those – seniors Morgan Klunk and Alex Ross; and sophomore Alyssa Mack combining for 28 of those points.
- Senior Morgan Klunk is the leading scorer among the returners from last season. Klunk averaged 33.3 minutes per game and was third on the team in scoring a year ago, posting 11.3 points per contest. She also led the team in assists (96), was second in steals (40), and was fourth in rebounds (133). Senior Ross started 25 games a year ago and averaged 9.6 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 2.7 assists for the Huskies.
- The Huskies also have sophomore Alyssa Mack returning after a fine freshman season. She was fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 7.1 points per game and she led the team with 31 three-pointers as a rookie. She was the PSAC East Freshman of the Week four times last season.

- Mansfield brings back seven players from the 2015-16 team including starters Brielle Kelly, Mary Kate Rumbaugh and Tianna Jackson. The trio combined for 23.9 points a game led by Kelly who averaged 12.1 points a game last year along with 6.2 boards an outing.
- The Mountaineers will have a new face on the sidelines in first year head coach Michael Whitling who comes to Mansfield after serving as an assistant at Gannon for the past three seasons under Jim Brunelli. Whitling helped the Golden Knights to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths at Gannon. Whitling also served as an assistant for Brunelli at Anderson (S.C.) for three seasons where he helped the Trojans to a South Atlantic Conference title in 2012-13.
- Mansfield ranked 13th in the PSAC in scoring last season averaging 71.1 points an outing but allowed a league worst 84.1 points to opponents.

#1 CALIFORNIA VULCANS

Quick Hits

- California enters the season as the two-time, defending-PSAC Champions. Over the past two seasons, the Vulcans have compiled a 57-10 record, including winning the 2015 NCAA Division II National Championship. Cal U has posted a 37-7 overall mark against PSAC opponents in the last two seasons and ended the 2015-16 regular-season on a 10-game winning streak
- The Vulcans finished with a 25-6 record last year despite losing three starters from the 2015 National Championship team due to graduation. Cal U was also without another starter from that team in Lana Doran, who suffered a season-ending injury in the preseason. After winning their second-straight PSAC Championship, the Vulcans advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- California has tallied at least 20 wins in three of the past five seasons under head coach Jess Strom. She has posted a 9-2 record while making three appearances in the NCAA Tournament and an 8-3 mark over five-straight appearances in the PSAC Tournament.
- The Vulcans return four starters from last season in Miki Glenn, Seairra Barrett, Shatara Parsons, and Precious Martin. Glenn was selected the PSAC West Athlete of the Year for 2015-16 and was named a WBCA All-American. She led the PSAC in scoring per game (19.3), steals per game (3.3) and minutes played per game (39.5). Barrett ranked fourth in the PSAC in rebounds per game (10.0) and Parsons finished third in the PSAC in blocks per game (1.9).

#2 IUP CRIMSON HAWKS

Quick Hits

- Only one starter - Jr. G/F Megan Smith - returns from last season's PSAC tournament runner-up team. Smith stepped up in her first year as a starter as a sophomore, finishing third on the team with 12.7 points per game, sec- ond with 6.4 rebounds per game, and shot 44.0 percent from 3-point range. She also shot 44.1 percent from the field, blocked 50 shots, and tallied three double-doubles.
- IUP lacks a true senior on the team for the first time under fourth year head coach Tom McConnell. McConnell has posted the best three-year start of any coach in program history, carrying a 64-23 (.736) overall record into this season.
