#1 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

Quick Hits

- ESU is coming off its first PSAC Final Four appearance since 2007, as the Warriors (19-9, 14-8) finished second in the PSAC East regular season standings and topped sixth-seeded Millersville 82-53 in the quarterfinal round. ESU's season ended on a last-second 71-69 defeat to California in the semifinals.
- Sr. F Allison Howard, Jr. G Imani Brown and So. G Noelle Powell were each named first team All-PSAC East last season, as the Warriors had three first-team selections for the first time in program history. Brown and Powell each return for their senior and junior seasons, respectively, this winter. Howard averaged a team-high 13.4 points and 6.8 rebounds per game as a senior, leaving ESU ranked seventh all-time in points (1,270) and eighth in rebounds (678).
- Powell ranked second in the PSAC last season in 3-point field goal percentage (40.9), and her 61 made 3-pointers were the second most in ESU single-season history. Brown added 47 made 3's for the Warriors, who were second in the conference in both 3-pointers made per game (7.5) and overall scoring offense (72.1 PPG).
- ESU relied on contributions from its entire roster last season, with the Warriors bench outscoring opponents in 24 of 28 games on the year. In 10 of those 24 occurrences, ESU reserves outscored opponents by 20+ points.
- The Warriors committed the fewest turnovers in the PSAC last season (408) and they were fourth in the conference in fewest turnovers per game (14.5). ESU won the turnover battle in 20 of 28 contests, going 14-6 when committing fewer giveaways than its opponents.

#2 WEST CHESTER GOLDEN RAMS

Quick Hits

- West Chester posted a record of 10-17 last season with the majority of the squad returning, including first-team, all-league selection Porscha Speller and second-team performer Madison Torresin. There is plenty of experience on the squad with eight returning players, three of which were starters. Providing a shooting presence from the outside is Camden Boehner. Transfer Mia Hopkins enters the fold this season, coming over from Bloomsburg where she averaged 16.1 points and 9.2 rebounds during the 2015-16 campaign.
- Team averaged 68.1 points per game with four of its top five scorers returning.
- West Chester posted a record of 10-17 last season, while being 10-12 in conference play.
- Head coach Kiera Wooden enters her fourth season, accumulating a 55-31 record (.639).
- West Chester fell to Bloomsburg last season in the opening round of the PSAC Women's Basketball Tournament.

#4 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

Quick Hits

- The Huskies return seven players from last season's team that finished fifth in the PSAC Eastern Division. Seven newcomers will join the roster for the 2017-18 season. No seniors are on this year's squad.
- Bloomsburg started the 2016-17 campaign with a 1-12 overall record and an 0-9 mark in the PSAC Eastern Division before going 10-5 over the last 15 games, including a 9-4 record in conference play to sneak into the fifth position in the Eastern Division. The Huskies knocked off West Chester on the road in the opening round of the conference tournament before dropping a decision at Shippensburg to end their season.
- The Huskies must find a way to replace Morgan Klunk and Alex Ross from last year's team. Klunk led the Huskies in scoring last season (13.2) and graduated as a 1,000-point scorer for her career. Ross, meanwhile, was second on the team in scoring (10.6), but led the team in rebounding (5.9), assists (73), and blocks (34).
- Alyssa Mack returns after finishing third on the team in scoring last season (9.8). She led the Huskies with 47 three-pointers and ranked third on the team in assists (49) and steals (27). Mack has averaged 8.5 points per game over her first two seasons and has knocked down 78 triples over two years.
- Bloomsburg should also get solid contributions from juniors Marissa Molnar (5.4 ppg) and Taylor Sneedman (4.8 ppg) as well as sophomores Taylor Montana (8.1 ppg, 4.7 rpg) and Meghan Corridoni (4.1 ppg, 3.9 rpg). Montana and Corridoni also combined to block 48 shots during their rookie seasons. Molnar and Sneedman combined for 42 three-pointers.

#5 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

Quick Hits

- Shippensburg has graduated all five of its starters and its six leading scorers from last season, a campaign in which the Raiders posted a 24-7 overall record – its most wins in 17 years – and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2002.
- Senior Victoria Blackburn returns as a captain for the second consecutive season. Blackburn averaged 3.5 points per game while playing 13.2 minutes as a junior last season, making 13 three-pointers. Her role is expected to expand this season.
- Shippensburg enters 2017-18 with nine freshmen on its 13-person roster.
- Blackburn and center Kristin McGeough are the only two seniors on the team, and there are no juniors. Both sophomores – Gabriela Blackburn and Nicole Thuemmel – are coming off redshirt seasons.
- The Raiders return just 154 points (V. Blackburn – 101, McGeough – 53) from last year's roster that totaled 2,154 points and ranked second in the league in scoring margin (+13.3 ppg).
- Shippensburg is coached by Kristy Trn, the 2016-17 PSAC Eastern Division Coach of the Year. Trn guided the Raiders to their first-ever PSAC Eastern Division title last season – SU's first divisional championship since winning the PSAC West in 2000-01. Trn, in her 19th season at Shippensburg, has posted a 322-172 career record.

Lister won multiple letters and named All-County in basketball and brings depth to Millersville's guard play.

Quick Hits

- The Edinboro women's basketball team is in search of its eight straight 20-win season after finishing with a 21-9 record a year ago. Edinboro has a 166-46 record during that period.
- Head coach Stan Swank enters his 31st season as head coach. He ranks tenth among active coaches in victories with 554 and is the all-time wins leader among PSAC women's coaches. He is six wins shy of passing Charles Chronister of Bloomsburg for the all-time record among men's and women's coaches.
- The Fighting Scots welcome back Whitney Allen after she played in just one game a year ago but suffered a season-ending injury against Wheeling Jesuit
- Michelle Jahn has been one of the top 3-point shooters her first two seasons. A year ago, she ranked ninth in the PSAC in 3-pointers per game, making 61. As a freshman, she made 71 3-pointers and ranked third in 3-pointers made per game. She already ranks ninth in career 3-pointers made at Edinboro with 132.
- The Edinboro roster features the last two PSAC West Freshmen of the Year in Michelle Jahn (2016) and Michaela Barnes (2017). Barnes averaged 8.0 ppg. while starting 27 games at guard.
- Three starters return, along with super sub Jontay Walton. 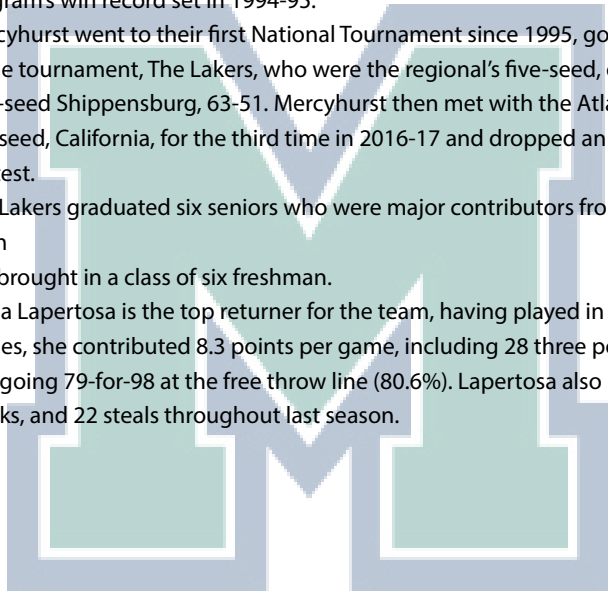
