# #1 IUP Crimson Hawks

### Quick Hits

- The Crimson Hawks return 13 starters from last year's PSAC Championship and NCAA semifinalist team; 11 returners earned All-PSAC West honors last year

- Paul Tortorella enters his second year as the IUP head coach after going 13-1 in 2017; it was the best debut season by a first year coach in program history, tying the record for wins in a season

- One of the best programs in Division II history with 560 all-time victories, IUP has 18 all-time NCAA playoff appearances, including four times in the last six seasons (2012, 2015-17)

- R-Sr. QB Lenny Williams, Jr. returns for his fourth year as taking snaps as the IUP starter; He has a 30-4 record as a starter, has led the Crimson Hawks to three NCAA playoff appearances, and owns 16 IUP records (four game, six season, six career)

- IUP returns four All-Americans from a year ago: Williams, Colin McAllister (OL), Damon Lloyd (LB), and JR Stevens (CB)

- RB Chris Temple returns to the IUP backfield after missing 2017 with an injury; he's eighth on the program's all-time rushing list with 2,539 rushing yards and second with 35 rushing touchdowns

- The IUP backfield includes four 1,000-yard rushers: Williams (1,229 in 2015), Temple (1,212 in 2015), RB Samir Bullock (1,252 in 2017) and RB Justice Evans (1,011 in 2017).

- Returning LBs Lloyd and Nick Amendola each tallied 100-plus tackles, combining for 225 in their first years as starters; Edge players Deandre Easterling and Dondrea Tillman combined for 27.5 TFLs and 17 sacks last year

### Quick Hits

- The Vulcans have made back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Playoffs for the first time since making five-consecutive appearances from 2007-11.

- Head coach Gary Dunn has posted the most victories ever by a Cal U head coach in his initial two seasons (20-4).

- Cal U has featured double-digit All-PSAC West selections in 13-consecutive seasons with senior DL Malik Akins and junior DB Lamont McPhatter II being the only returning All-PSAC West selections in 2018.

- The Vulcans are the only PSAC program to win at least seven games every year since the 2005 campaign.

### #3 Slippery Rock The Rock

#### Quick Hits

- SRU returns 10 players that started multiple games on defense last year and loses just two players, but one of those was the consensus National Defensive Player of the Year and the all-time NCAA career record holder in sacks and tackles for loss, Marcus Martin.

- All-PSAC placekicker and punter Jake Chapla returns for his junior season having already made 22 career field goals. He has his sights set on the SRU career record of 35 field goals set by CJ Bahr and Morgan Anderson. Chapla scored 86 points for SRU last season and has hit from a career-long 51 yards already just two years into his college career.

- SRU returns three seasoned players on the offensive line, including two-time All-PSAC tackle Steve Gaviglia, and adding a powerful Division I transfer running back in Wes Hills (Delaware), that the running game will be more prevalent in the offense this year.

- SRU has one of the toughest schedules in the region on paper as it will play three NCAA playoff qualifying teams from last fall (Indiana, California, Shippensburg) with all three of those games coming on the road.

### #4 Edinboro Fighting Scots

#### Quick Hits

- Edinboro enters the 2018 campaign nationally ranked in a pair of preseason polls. The Fighting Scots are picked to finish 18th in Lindy's Division II Preseason Top 25, and are ranked 24th in Street & Smith's preseason rankings.

- The Fighting Scots feature a pair of preseason All-Americans and three returning All-Americans. Redshirt junior running back Walter Fletcher was named to the Street & Smith's preseason All-American squad, while Fletcher and senior corner-back Zuril Hendrick earned spots on the second team of Lindy's preseason All-American team. Hendrick has also been named to the College Football America 2018 Yearbook Division II Preseason All-American Team.

- Hendrick led Division II in interceptions a year ago with nine. He returned the interceptions for a school-record 201 yards, bringing back two for touchdowns. He ranked fifth on the team in tackles with 59, and had a team-high 10 passes broken up. Hendrick was accorded first team Don Hansen NCAA II All-American honors and was a second team All-PSAC West choice.

# #5 Gannon Golden Knights

### Quick Hits

- Senior Jarod Morrison returns as Gannon's starting punter after breaking the program's single-season punting average last year with a 42.6-yard average in 38 punts.

- Senior linebacker Anthony Howard enters the season 23rd all-time at Gannon with 208 career tackles. He needs 41 tackles to move into Gannon's all-time top 10.

- Gannon broke the program's single-season records for yards per play (6.7), rushing yards (3,061), yards per rush (6.6), rushing touchdowns (42), points (426) and touchdowns (61).

- Senior tailback Marcus Jones returns after finishing runner-up in last year's Harlon Hill Trophy voting. His 2017 postseason resume included The Associated Press NCAA Division II All-America first team, American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) All-America first team, NCAA Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCA) All-America first team, D2Football.com All-America first team and Don Hansen Football Gazette first team. He was named Don Hansen Football Gazette Super Region One Player of the Year, Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Western Division Offensive Player of the Year and Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC)

# #6 Mercyhurst Lakers

### Quick Hits

- Four All-PSAC players return, including three West First Team players: senior tight end Bryce Mostoller (14 rec, 128 yds), senior cornerback Dante' Redwood (51 TT, 2 INTs, 14 PBUs) and redshirt-junior punter Brendan Cole (44 punts, 1,872 yds, 42.5 avg); and one Second Team player: junior linebacker Corbin Kessler (64 TT, sack, 2 INTs, 2 FRs)

- Four Don Hansen Gazette Super Region players return, including Third Team players Cole, Mostoller and Redwood. Senior fullback Theophilus Blackston III (30 rec, 209 yds, 3 TDs), who was on the Third Team, also returns

- Blackston, who transitioned to the defensive line to fullback, was also named to the Don Hansen Gazette All-America Third Team last year

- The Lakers return their leading passer, leading rusher and leading tackler from 2017. Redshirt-junior quarterback Doug Altavilla was 198 of 340 for 2,345 yards, 15 touchdowns and 12 interceptions last year. He had a 123.7 efficiency rating. ### Quick Hits

- Running back Mylique McGriff turned into the one of the most dangerous running backs in the league in the second half of last season, averaging 127.0 rushing yards and 157.4 all-purpose yards per game in the final five contests of the year

- The Golden Eagles will have a different look this year as they welcome a total of 51 newcomers to the roster this year, including more than 40 freshmen

- 2017 All-PSAC West selection Layne Skundrich enters the season with 223 career tackles after notching 106 a year ago, and is on pace to enter the program's top-10 all-time in total tackles

- The bulk of Clarion's returning defensive depth comes on the defensive line, including returning All-PSAC West performers Alec Heldreth and Brandon Vocco.

- Offensive lineman Zack Morris is a two-time All-PSAC West performer and a two-time Don Hansen Football Gazette All-Super Region 1 selection. He is trying to become Clarion's first three-time All-PSAC performer on the offensive line since Mike Felker (2010-13).

# #2 Shippensburg Red Raiders

### Quick Hits

- SHIP is coming off a 10-2 season in which it made its sixth NCAA postseason appearance in school history. Head Coach Mark 'Mac' Maciejewski was named the 2017 AFCA Division II Region 1 Coach of the Year and the 2017 PSAC Eastern Division Coach of the Year for instructing SU to its fifth 10-win season in school history. SU has now posted seven straight winning seasons for the first time since 1950-57.

- SHIP returns eight defensive starters to a unit that posted the top red-zone defense in NCAA Division II (.556) in 2017 and led the PSAC in numerous statistical categories, including turnover margin (1.33; 2nd in D2), scoring defense (13.0; 3rd in D2), team pass efficiency defense (89.55; 3rd in D2), total defense (268.8; 4th in D2) and defensive touchdowns (5; 8th in D2).

- Among the players to watch on offense is the PSAC Eastern Division Freshman of the Year, wide receiver Winston Eubanks. In 2017, Eubanks became the first SU freshman in history to finish a season with 10 or more receiving touchdowns. He ranked second in Division II in yards per reception (26.71) and eighth nationally in receiving yards (1,202).

- Key losses for the Red Raiders include All-PSAC performers Ryan Zapoticky (QB), Cole Chiappialle (RB), Kevin Taylor II (DB) and Chavez Cheatham (DB).

# #7 Lock Haven Bald Eagles

### Quick Hits

- Lock Haven finished the 2017 season at 2-9 overall. The Bald Eagles went 2-5 in PSAC East action with the divisional wins coming over Cheyney and local-rival Bloomsburg. It marked LHU's second straight win over Bloomsburg and moved third-year head coach Dave Taynor to 2-1 all-time vs. Bloomsburg.

- Leading the way for the Bald Eagles in 2017 was the run-game. LHU finished with 2,182 rushing yards and Lock Haven finished with 198.4 yards per game, which ranked as the fourth-best rushing offense in the PSAC at the end of the regular season. Leading the way was rising sophomore quarterback Kyle Knight who rushed for eight touchdowns. Knight ran for 76 yards per game. As a team, LHU ran for 20 TDs with 18 of 20 coming in the final six games. As a team, Lock Haven recorded three games with 300 or more rushing yards including a single-game school record of 460 (6 rushing TDs) in the win over Cheyney.

- Knight ran for 104 yards in his career-debut at perennial power Slippery Rock in Week 2 action and the rest was history as he then rattled off a remarkable "run" over the next seven games. In all, the two-time PSAC Offensive Player of the Week, made six starts (10GP) and finished with 760 rushing yards (76/game), 655 passing yards (65.5/game), 10 total touchdowns (8 rush, 2 pass) and he threw for just two interceptions in 114 attempts. Knight recorded four games of 100-plus rushing yards including 174 in the comeback-win at Bloomsburg.

- Over the second half of the season, it was a pair of true-freshmen from nearby Williamsport, Pennsylvania, who emerged as the leaders in the Bald Eagles receiving corps. Despite their youth last season tight end Jalen Jackson and wide receiver Elliot Walker made a name for themselves. Jackson finished as LHU's top receiver with 30.2 receiving-yards per game. In all (11GP/7GS), he made 26 catches for 332 yards. Walker (8GP/5GS) finished with 19 catches for 238 yards (29.8 yds./game). The rising sophomores will look to make some noise in 2018.
