## #1 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

### Quick Hits

- The Warriors young roster this season consists of seven freshmen and five sophomores, giving them 12 underclassmen out of 16 total players.
- The team's top returning scorers are senior forward Michal Weiss (6.5 ppg) and Montrel Morgan (6.1 ppg). Weiss ranked third on the Warriors last season with 3.5 rebounds per game.
- ESU finished atop the PSAC East regular season standings in 2018-19 with a conference mark of 17-3. The Warriors received three of the East Division's four major awards as Ryan Smith was named Freshman of the Year, Jakwan Jones was honored as Defensive Athlete of the Year, and Jeff Wilson took home his fourth Coach of the Year honor in the last 10 seasons.
- HC Jeff Wilson became the ninth coach in PSAC history to reach 300 career wins with a victory over Felician in November of last season. Wilson's Warriors have posted at least 16 wins in each of the last 14 seasons, including seven 20-win seasons.
- Rookie Justin Paz (Bethlehem, Pa./Bethlehem Catholic) holds the career record (263) for three-pointers in EPC/Lehigh Valley Conference in high school. He left Bethlehem Catholic as the school's all-time leading scorer (1,898).

## #2 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

### Quick Hits

- Ship is 95-28 over the last four seasons, reaching the PSAC Tournament each season and making two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2018-19 season marked the fourth consecutive 20-win campaign for the Raiders under head coach Chris Fite. SU had achieved two 20-win seasons in its 62 previous seasons.
- The 2018-19 campaign marked the first time in SU Men's Basketball history that the Raiders had multiple players in the same season selected to the All-PSAC First Team. Junior point guard Jacob Biss is one of two returning All-PSAC players for the Raiders alongside two-time Second Team selection, senior forward John Castello.
- Shippensburg ranked third in the nation in offensive rebounds per game in 2018-19 (15.07), while its +6.8 rebound margin ranked 12th in the nation.
- SHIP has a knack for three-pointers, making 278 three-pointers last season (third-most in the PSAC). In each of the previous two seasons, SHIP set single-season school records for three-pointers (345 in 2017-18, 317 in 2016-17).
- The Raiders will have to make up for the loss of Antonio Kellem and Manny Span – the winningest senior class in school history. The two men contributed to a 95-28 record in their four seasons on the court. Kellem completed a 116-game career ranked eighth in SU history with 1,486 points. Span completed a 110-game career with a dynamic senior season that included single-season career bests in points (225) and rebounds (218).

### #3 WEST CHESTER GOLDEN RAMS

#### Quick Hits

- The Golden Rams have won at least 16 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference regular season games in three of the last four seasons.
- West Chester last reached the PSAC Championship Game in 2015-16. At that point, the Golden Rams had reached the championship three times in five years.
- Damian Blair reached 203 career wins last season. Only he and former head coach Dick DeLaney have reached the 200-win mark at West Chester
- Senior guard Malik Jackson is 14th on West Chester's all-time scoring list and second in three pointers. With 400 points, Jackson can climb to fourth all-time. He needs 93 threes to surpass his coach, Damian Blair, for the school record.
- The Golden Rams have made an NCAA Tournament appearance in four of the last six seasons.

### #4 MILLERSVILLE MARAUDERS

#### Quick Hits

- Millersville returns four starters from a team that went 16-13 overall and 11-9 in the PSAC East. Millersville finished fourth in the PSAC East—the program's highest finish since 2014-15.
- Jaden Faulkner was named All-PSAC East Second Team in 2019, becoming only the sixth freshman in Millersville history to earn all-conference honors. He was named PSAC East Freshman of the Week four times and ranked fourth in the PSAC in both steals and assists.
- James Sullivan and Caden Najdawi are entering their third seasons as starters for Millersville. Najdawi ranked 12th in the PSAC in rebounding and sixth in blocks in 2018-19. Sullivan has started 57 of the team's 58 games in his first two seasons.
- Millersville added transfer Khari Williams from Clarion. Williams led Clarion in scoring at 13.6 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from 3-point range.
- Millersville has increased its win total in each of Casey Stitzel's first three seasons. He inherited a four win team and has reached the postseason in each of the last two years.

### #6 LOCK HAVEN BALD EAGLES

#### Quick Hits

- LHU finished the season at 12-15 overall and went 8-12 in Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) action. The Bald Eagles made a return trip to the postseason for the first time since the 2016-17 season, but fell in a thrilling upset bid against Shippensburg, 71-70.
- All-PSAC Second Team guard Christian Kelly finished ninth in the conference in rebounding. The junior led the team, by hauling in 7.9 rebounds per game, and tallying five double-doubles.
- As a team, Lock Haven finished seventh in the PSAC in field goal percentage. For the year, the Bald Eagles shot 44.7 percent from the floor. Jesse McPherson posted a team best 52 percent mark from the field, just behind him was Matt Cerruti who shot 51.3 percent.
- First Team All PSAC guard Matt Cerruti lit up the scoreboard all year long for the Bald Eagles, scoring 20 points per game. That mark was best on the team and good for fourth place in the conference.
- Lock Haven was first in the conference as a team in free throw shooting percentage at 72.7 percent. Highlighting this impressive stat was Noah Warren shooting 83 percent and Matt Cerruti at 80 percent from the stripe.

### #8 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

#### Quick Hits

- The Huskies went 7-19 overall and 3-17 in the PSAC Eastern Division last season – the program's first losing season since the 2014-15 campaign.
- Senior Ky Mauras returns to the Huskies' lineup after missing the final 12 games of the year last season. He started all 14 games he appeared in last year and led the Huskies in scoring at 18.3 points per game. He finished third on the team in assists (52) despite missing nearly half of the season. In two seasons at Bloomsburg, Mauras is averaging 15.3 points, 4.6 rebounds, and 4.1 assists per game. He needs 373 points to record 1,000 for his career.
- Sophomore Travis Elmore had a sensational rookie campaign for the Huskies as he posted 15.7 points and 7.4 rebounds while shooting 57.0% from the field (third in the PSAC). He recorded six double-doubles and reached double figures in scoring in 23 of his 26 games. He led Bloomsburg in scoring ten times and in rebounding ten times last season.
- Redshirt senior Sam Saxton had his best season at Bloomsburg last season, averaging 9.7 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 2.6 assists – all career-highs. He should once again be in the starting lineup this season as a "jack of all trades" on both ends of the floor.
- Other returners to watch for the Huskies include sophomore William Melson (3.6 ppg, 2.2 apg), redshirt junior Peyton Mortellite (7.7 ppg, 35 threes), sophomore Devon Ferrero (2.5 ppg, 2.1 rpg), and junior Ethan Houston (4.5 ppg, 3.4 rpg). Redshirt junior Max Wagner missed all of last season after transferring from Kutztown and should provide stability at the power forward/center position.

#### Quick Hits

- Mansfield returns three starters and seven players from a year ago including leading scorer Tyler Moffe who averaged 16.8 ppg last season as a junior. Taylor Sweeney was second on the team in scoring at 13.5 ppg and Garrett Cook was fourth at 10.7 ppg. All three made starts in all 28 games last season.
- Garrett Cook led the PSAC and ranked 13th in the nation in 3-point FG pct. a year ago at 45.0% while Taylor Sweeney topped the conference and was seventh in the nation in minutes per game at 38:18.
- Mansfield welcomes a class of nine newcomers including five junior college or four-year university transfers.
- The Mounties were one of the more disciplined teams in the country in 201-19, ranking 16th in Division II in fewest fouls committed at 14.5 an outing.
- Head Coach John Szentesy enters his second season at the helm of his alma mater.

## WESTERN DIVISION

### #1 IUP CRIMSON HAWKS

#### Quick Hits

- The reigning PSAC champions return one starter (senior Malik Miller) and five letterwinners from last year's 30-3 squad that earned the No. 1 seed in the Atlantic Region tournament and finished the year ranked No. 2 in the NABC Coaches' Poll. IUP brought in four Division I transfers and three true freshmen for 2019-20.
- IUP is the only PSAC West program to win at least four straight divisional titles. The Crimson Hawks have done it twice – five straight from 2010-14 and a current run of four straight 2016-19.
- Last year's PSAC title was the 10th all-time for the program, tying Millersville for second in conference history. The 10 titles is the most by any team from the Western Division.
- Miller has played in 90 games at IUP with 35 starts and enters this season with 970 points. He earned first team All-PSAC West honors in his first year as a starter, averaging 16.4 points with a 42.8 field goal percentage at 72 made 3-pointers.
- Heading into his 14th year at the helm, head coach Joe Lombardi is 305-100 (.753) with four PSAC Championships, nine divisional titles, and two appearances in the Division II national championship game. He was the fastest coach in PSAC history to 300 career wins and his current mark of 305 ranks 10th all-time.

### #2 SLIPPERY ROCK THE ROCK

#### Quick Hits

- Slippery Rock returns eight players, seven of which played in at least 18 games, from a team that went 19-10 a year ago and qualified for the PSAC Tournaments. Included in the 19 wins were a 16-5 PSAC record and wins over NCAA Tournament qualifiers Indiana (Pa.), West Chester and Mercyhurst (twice).
- Head coach Ian Grady is back for his second season in charge of the Slippery Rock men's basketball program. Grady's 19 wins a year ago were the most victories by any of the 18 active PSAC head coaches in their first years at their current schools.
- Headlining the returners for The Rock are 2018-19 All-PSAC West selections senior forward Micah Till and senior guard Jared Armstrong. Till, an All-America candidate, averaged 21 points, 10 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 2.1 steals and 2.0 blocks per game a year ago. Armstrong came off the bench in all 29 games to average 16.4 points per game while shooting 45.6 percent from the field overall, 42.9 percent from 3-point range and 80.7 percent at the foul line.
- Other key returners for SRU from a season ago include sophomore forward Will Bounds, sophomore guard Amante Britt, sophomore guard Nik Cazacu, sophomore guard Jason Fowlkes and senior guard Donovan Walker, a Division I transfer who missed all of last year due to injury.
- Slippery Rock has recorded winning seasons in 10 of the last 11 years, averaging 18.8 wins per year over that time span to go with nine PSAC Tournament berths and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

### #T7 EDINBORO FIGHTING SCOTS

#### Quick Hits

- Anthony Coleman returns after missing all but the first four games of the 2018-19 season with an injury. Coleman was a second team All-PSAC West selection as a junior in 2017-18, averaging 15.2 ppg. Was one of the top 3-point threats in the conference, making 72-of-174 3-pointers (41.4 pct.). He ranked sixth in the PSAC in 3-point field goal percentage and was tied for seventh 3-point field goals made per game (2.5). He ranks ninth in a season in 3-point field goal percentage at Edinboro, along with tied for ninth in 3-pointers made per game and 16th in 3-pointers attempted. A year ago, he averaged 12.3 ppg. while being injured early in the fourth game.
- Jaryn Simpson stepped up last year to earn second team All-PSAC West accolades in Coleman's absence. After averaging 3.4 ppg. as a freshman, Simpson enjoyed a breakout season as a sophomore. He led the Fighting Scots in scoring at 18.0 ppg., ranking ninth in the PSAC. He made 76-of-210 3-pointers and was at 90.2 percent from the line (110-of-122). He set a school-record for free throw percentage while leading the PSAC, as well. His 76 3-pointers made ranks eighth in a season, and the 210 3-pointers attempted are fifth. A 6'3" guard, Simpson was tied for second on the team in rebounds at 5.5 per game, while leading the team in assists (115).
- Simpson ranked seventh in the conference in assists per game (4.4) and sixth in 3-pointers made per game (2.9) and 12th in 3-point field goal percentage. He also was an ironman for the Fighting Scots, averaging 37.3 minutes, good for fourth in the PSAC. Simpson had Edinboro's first triple-double since Ryan McLemore had one against Slippery Rock on February 13, 2008. Simpson scored 25 points, adding a career-high 14 rebounds and matching his career-best with 11 assists in the second meeting with Pitt-Johnstown.
- After playing football for four seasons, Trey Stauch returns for his third season of basketball, but his first playing just one sport. A former All-PSAC West performer at offensive tackle, at 6'4", 285 lbs., Stauch is undersized but provides plenty of muscle inside. He boosted his scoring average from 8.0 ppg. to 14.4 ppg., and his rebounds from 3.7 to 7.4 rpg. Stauch shot 52.0 percent from the floor.
