### #1 WEST CHESTER GOLDEN RAMS

#### Quick Hits

- West Chester returns four starters from last year's team that finished 22-7 overall and won a game in the NCAA tournament for the first time in program history.
- Of their four returning starters, three earned PSAC laurels last season: Matt Penecale (All-PSAC East Second Team), Jackson Hyland (All-PSAC East Second Team), and Frank Rokins (PSAC East Defensive Athlete of the Year).
- After a year away from the team, junior guard Malik Jackson returns for the Golden Rams in 2018-19. Jackson averaged 19.2 points per game during the 2016-17 season and was named All-PSAC East Second Team for his efforts. Jackson's 19.2 points per game (No. 5 in the PSAC) during his sophomore campaign stands as the highest scoring average by a WCU player since 2002-03.
- The Golden Rams added four newcomers over the offseason, including two big men (both 6-8) and a high-scoring guard. Head Coach Damian Blair also junior added combo guard Ian Langendoerfer, who comes to West Chester after appearing in 39 games for NCAA DI Loyola University (Maryland).
- Senior guard Matt Penecale enters his final season with the Golden Rams just 59 assists away (397 for his career) from breaking WCU's all-time assists record.

### #2 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

#### Quick Hits

- ESU is the defending PSAC champion and NCAA DII Atlantic Region champion, earning its first-ever regional title with an 84-72 win vs. Shippensburg last March and finishing with a 27-6 record - including 13 straight wins before falling to eventual national runner-up Northern State in the Elite 8
- ESU won its 3rd PSAC title in the last 7 years (2012, 2014, 2018) and 4th in school history, running past Edinboro 98-75 in the semifinals and Gannon 89-67 in the championship game
- R-Sr. G Jakwan Jones, 2nd team All-PSAC East and 2nd in the PSAC in assists (5.7 apg), leads a group that returns 6 of 10 players that scored at least 5 ppg last year as the Warriors ranked 4th in DII in scoring (92.0 ppg), led DII in steals (11.5) and was 2nd in turnover margin (+6.7)
- ESU's 4 key departures include forward Steve Harris (15.4 ppg, 7.3 rpg, 66.0 fg%), 1st team All-PSAC East, NABC All-Region and MVP of the PSAC and Atlantic Regional tournaments
- Head coach Jeff Wilson ranks 9th in PSAC history in career wins (298) and has led ESU to 3 PSAC titles, 5 PSAC East regular season titles and 5 NCAA Tournaments since 2010

## EASTERN DIVISION

### #3 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

#### Quick Hits

- Shippensburg returns two starters from a squad that posted a 25-8 overall record and reached the NCAA Atlantic Region Championship game ("Sweet Sixteen") for the first time in school history. The Raiders made their second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and fourth overall in school history.
- Shippensburg led the country last season in free-throw percentage (80.6 percent; 495-of-614). That total is the best in PSAC single-season history and ranks 10th all-time in NCAA Division II single-season history. The Raiders also set new single-season school records last season for total points (2,666), three-pointers (345) and assists (544).
- SU must account for the departure of its 2017-18 senior class (two-time All-American Dustin Sleva, school-record holder for career three-pointers Justin McCarthur, and point guard Clay Conner). The three seniors combined for 4,332 points, 1,534 rebounds, 953 assists, 574 three-pointers, 1,028 free throws and a combined 80.6 free-throw percentage.
- SU's roster breakdown features two seniors, five juniors, two sophomores and six freshman. The Raiders have 10 returning players and five newcomers. Of the five newcomers, two are JUCO transfers. In addition to returning starters Antonio Kellem and John Castello, returning contributors Jake Biss, Manny Span, Dom Sleva and Lamar Talley are among those expected to have significantly expanded roles this season.
- Shippensburg is coached by Chris Fite, the 2016-17 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Atlantic Region Coach of the Year and the 2016-17 PSAC Eastern Division Coach of the Year. SU has achieved three straight 20-win seasons under Fite after totaling two 20-win seasons in its previous 62 years of basketball. Over the last three seasons, SU has posted a 72-21 record under Fite.

### #4 KUTZTOWN GOLDEN BEARS

#### Quick Hits

- KU returns two starters, including All-PSAC East First Team member Anthony Lee and PSAC East Freshman of the Year Moe Williams. Both are team captains.
- Lee is a 3x All-PSAC performer who averaged 21.5 points (4th in PSAC) last season and led Division II with a KU single-season record with a 51.6 3-point percentage.
- Williams finished with 8.7 rebounds per game last season which ranked sixth in the PSAC, and also ranked 10th in blocks per game (1.0). He was a 5x PSAC East Freshman of the Week.
- Head coach Bernie Driscoll, the winningest coach in Kutztown history, won his 300th career game last season and holds a 307-204 career record, ranking eighth in PSAC history in career wins.
- Kutztown begins its 2018-19 campaign in West Virginia at the PSAC-Mountain East Conference Challenge. KU opens with West Liberty, a team that reached the NCAA Tournament last season.

### #5 MILLERSVILLE MARAUDERS

#### Quick Hits

- Marcus Adkison, an All-PSAC East Second Team selection in 2017-18, is Millersville's first returning All-PSAC East player since Charlie Parker and Reggie Bates in 2007-08.
- Adkison ranked 11th in the PSAC in scoring in 2017-18, posting the highest season average by a Marauder in 10 years. He also ranked fifth in 3-point field goal percentage. He is one of only three players in Millersville history to have two entries on the single-season top-10 list for 3-pointers made. He also set a single-season Millersville record for free throw percentage (.870).
- Adkison led the PSAC in steals with 63.
- In 2017-18, Millersville led the PSAC in minutes played by freshmen but still made the PSAC Tournament for the first time since 2014-15.
- Millersville added seven freshmen and eight total newcomers to its roster. The team has just two seniors in Adkison and Amadou Kaba. Kaba started 24 games and led the team in blocked shots in 2016-17 but missed all of 2017-18 with an injury.

### #6 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

#### Quick Hits

- Bloombsburg has made the PSAC tournament in each of the last three seasons and in six of the last seven years. The Huskies, however, have not advanced past the first round of the playoffs since the 2013-14 season.
- Head coach John Sanow enters his 13th season as the head coach of the Huskies and has guided the team to a 148-175 overall record. He ranks second in Bloombsburg's all-time career coaching victories list, trailing only Charlie Chronister who won 559 games from 1971-2002.
- The Huskies must find a way to replace Christian Mortellite who graduated as the school's all-time leading scorer with 2,037 career points and the program's all-time leader in career three-pointers with 314. Also lost to graduation are Kyle-Michael Rose (second all-time in career blocks at Bloombsburg with 135) and Hashim Moore who averaged 10.4 points and 5.1 rebounds last season in his only year at Bloombsburg.
- Bloombsburg returns two starters – junior Ky Mauras and redshirt junior Sam Saxton. Mauras recorded what is believed to be the program's first-ever triple-double last season with 21 points, 11 rebounds, and 13 assists in a win over Lock Haven. Saxton, meanwhile, was third on the team with 19 three-pointers.
- The Huskies only have one senior on the roster – Darius Robinson-Wallace – who has averaged 2.5 points and 1.8 rebounds in 45 career games (seven starts).

### #T7 MANSFIELD MOUNTAINEERS

#### Quick Hits

- Newly appointed Head Coach John Szentesy will lead the Mountaineers in 2018-19 after serving as an assistant coach with Mansfield since 2014. Szentesy brings experience from the high school, college, and professional ranks to his alma mater.
- Mansfield returns six student-athletes from a year ago including senior Tyler Moffe who averaged 31.0 minutes a game. Moffe was second on the team in made 3-point field goals last season with 29 and averaged 8.2 points a game.
- Junior Reilly Collins and sophomore Taylor Sweeney are poised for breakout seasons after seeing good playing time last season. Collins appeared in 19 games in 2017-18 and Sweeney scored a career-high 12 points against West Chester. Dan Ransom looks to bounce back from an off-season injury to be the Mounties' primary threat in the paint this year after appearing in all 26 games last season.
- The Mountaineers are looking to return to the PSAC playoffs for the first time since the 2012-13 season. Mansfield won back-to-back PSAC East titles in 2009-10 and 2010-11 and earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 2011.
- Mansfield opens the 2018-19 season at the Shaw University Tournament on Nov. 10 and hosts Salem University in the home opener at Decker Gymnasium on Nov. 28.

### #1 IUP CRIMSON HAWKS

#### Quick Hits

- The Crimson Hawks return three starters and four more lettermen from last year's PSAC West regular season title team that went 22-8 overall and 18-4 in conference play. Starters coming back include guard Dante Lombardi and forwards Jacobo Diaz and Willem Brandwijk – all seniors.
- IUP received preseason rankings of No. 2 in the Street & Smith's Basketball Yearbook and No. 13 in the Division II Bulletin for the 2018-19 season.
- Diaz is a two-time first team all-conference selection who earned honorable mention All-American honors and was named the PSAC West Athlete of the Year as a sophomore in 2017. He was named a 2018-19 preseason All-American by both the DII Bulletin and Street & Smith's.
- Lombardi has played 88 games with 69 starts, earning All-PSAC West honors each of his previous three years. With 397 career assists, he's 115 shy of tying Devante Chance's program record of 512.
- IUP head coach Joe Lombardi enters his 13th season with the Crimson Hawks and carries a 275-97 (.739) overall record with eight NCAA tournament appearances, eight regular season division titles, three PSAC tournament championships (2010, 2011, 2013), two Atlantic Region Championships (2010, 2015), and two Division II national title game appearances (2010, 2015).
- Lombardi is 12th in PSAC history and third amongst active coaches with 275 career wins.

### #2 SLIPPERY ROCK THE ROCK

#### Quick Hits

- Slippery Rock is under the direction of 11th year head coach Kevin Reynolds. Reynolds has averaged 17.1 wins per year since taking over the program in 2008. His teams have won 20 or more games six times in the last 10 years and have reached three NCAA Division II postseason tournaments. SRU is coming off a 21-9 overall record last winter that ended in the second round of the PSAC tournament.
- Slippery Rock returns just one player from the 2017-18 roster in All-American forward Micah Till. The rest of The Rock roster includes one player from a former SRU team in Vinny Lasley, who played in 2016-17, but did not play last year. The rest of the roster is made up of 10 transfer students and four true freshmen.
- Micah Till was named a Street and Smith Preseason All-American entering this winter. He was one of the most dominant players in Division II last winter in his first season at SRU, when he averaged 21.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game. He ranked third in the nation in double-doubles after the regular season after putting up 22 double-doubles in 30 games and he scored more than 20 points in 21 different outings. Till led the nation in total rebounds over the regular season and was the only player in the country to score at least 600 points and grab at least 350 rebounds during the regular season. He finished the year ranked third all-time in single-season scoring at SRU (640 points) and set a new program record for single-season rebounds with 361. He also blocked 45 shots, had 40 steals, handed out 38 assists and shot .494 from the field and a team-high .728 from the free throw line.
- Transfer Guard John Warren II started 62 games and appeared in 99 games for Augustana University over three years before missing last season. He was named an All-Conference player in the NSIC after his junior year in 2016-17 after averaging 14.1 points, 5.7 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.6 steals per game.

- Despite bringing back just one starter, the Golden Knights do return five players who appeared in at least 26 games last season, and three who averaged double-digit minutes.
- Gannon reached the PSAC tournament championship game for the third time in 10 seasons in the league last year, finishing 22-10 for their fourth 20-win season in the past six years.
- Last season, Gannon assisted on 16 of their 27.3 field goals per game (58.6 percent). Five different players averaged at least 2.0 assists per game.
- For the second straight season, Gannon will open up against Wheeling Jesuit and Shepherd in the MEC-PSAC Conference Challenge.

- Mercyhurst graduated its top two scorers from last year, but does return Nos. 3-5 in Patrick Smith (8.9), Derrick Ellis Jr. (7.3) and Edvaldo Ferreira (5.0)
- The Laker roster has more newcomers (8) than returners (7), but does not lack experience as it includes D-I graduate transfer Jason Massey (Brown), D-II transfer Mamadou Diakhaby (Bridgeport), NAIA transfer Trystan Pratapas (Keiser) and community college transfer Malik Jones (Harford). #### Quick Hits

- Pat Cleary was named the PSAC West Coach of the Year after leading Edinboro to an 18-11 finish after going 8-18 in 2016-17. The Fighting Scots were picked to finish eighth in last year's PSAC preseason poll, but would end the season fourth. The Fighting Scots would defeat Pitt-Johnstown in the first round of the PSAC Tournament, and upset top seed IUP in the quarterfinals before losing to eventual PSAC champion East Stroudsburg in the semifinals. Cleary begins his sixth season at the helm of the Fighting Scots.
- Two starters return, led by second team All-PSAC West performer Anthony Coleman. The 6'3" senior guard averaged 15.2 ppg. and was one of the top 3-point threats in the conference, ranking sixth in 3-point field goal percentage (41.4 pct.) and tied for seventh in 3-pointers made per game (2.5). He finished third on the team in scoring and was the top 3-point threat, making 72 in 174 attempts.
- Edinboro must replace two of the top players to play at Edinboro in recent years. In fact, Jaymon Mason departed as Edinboro's all-time leading scorer with 2,005 points and was a two-time All-American and three-time All-PSAC performer. Keshawn Liggins was named to several All-American teams and was a first team All-PSAC selection a year ago after leading the PSAC in scoring at 23.8 ppg. and finishing third in rebounding at 10.4 per game.
- Cleary is expecting Trey Stauch to once again join the basketball team when the football season concludes. A year ago, Stauch proved a huge factor in Edinboro's stretch run. A starter in over 30 games at right tackle, he transitioned to the hardcourt after not playing since high school. The 6'4", 270 lb. forward would average 8.0 ppg. and 3.7 rpg. while coming off the bench and averaging just over 17 minutes per contest.
