Quick Hits

- KU finished last season 19-12 overall and 14-6 in the PSAC, winning a share of the PSAC East title, the first title since 1996.
- Kutztown hosted the PSAC final four for the first time in program history and advanced to its first ever PSAC Championship game.
- Returns three starters, including All-PSAC East First Teamer Rylee Derr and Second Teamer Karen Lapkiewicz.
- KU's 253 made 3-pointers were the most in a season, and Derr's 89 3-pointers are the most by a single player.
- Head coach Janet Malouf, in her 26th season, holds a 372-323 overall record, fourth in PSAC history in career wins.

#2 BLOOMSBURG HUSKIES

Quick Hits

- Bloomsburg finished the 2018-19 season with a 20-10 overall record, reaching 20 wins and advancing to the PSAC Semifinals for the first time since the 2014-15 campaign. The Huskies went a perfect 14-0 at home last season – the first undefeated home record at home since the 1989-90 campaign.
- Head coach Alison Tagliaferri was named the PSAC East Coach of the Year for the first time in her career. She has led Bloomsburg to the PSAC tournament in each of her first three seasons and guided the Huskies to at least a share of the PSAC East regular season crown since 2014-15. Tagliaferri is the first coach in PSAC history to win Coach of the Year and Athlete of the Year honors (Mansfield, 2006) on the women's side.
- The Huskies return four of their five starters from last year including a pair of All-PSAC East honorees in senior Taylor Montana and junior Emma Saxton. Montana earned First Team accolades after leading the team in rebounding (7.0 rpg) and finished second on the team in scoring (12.4 ppg). She also posted a team-high 25 blocked shots and recorded a team-best five double-doubles. She reached double figures in scoring 20 times and needs 150 points to reach 1,000 for her career. Saxton, meanwhile, was a Second Team honoree after leading the Huskies in scoring (12.5 ppg) while ranking second in the PSAC in field goal percentage (56.3%). She reached double figures in scoring 21 times and has totaled 587 points in her first two seasons.
- Senior Bella Ricci enjoyed her best season at Bloomsburg, averaging 8.4 points and 3.0 rebounds while posting a team-high 74 assists. Junior Megan Brandt caught fire late in the season and averaged 7.5 points, primarily off the bench for the Huskies. She reached double figures in nine of her last ten games last year while starting seven of the final eight contests.
- The biggest addition for the Huskies will arguably be the return of redshirt junior Meghan Corridoni who missed all of last season due to injury. In her most recent campaign two years ago, Corridoni posted 7.7 points and 4.9 rebounds while starting 27 games. She also led with 29 blocks.

EASTERN DIVISION #3 SHIPPENSBURG RAIDERS

Quick Hits

- Junior guard Ariel Jones was named to the 2018-19 Division II Conference Commissioners Association (D2CCA) All-America Women's Basketball Third Team, D2CCA All-Atlantic Region First Team and All-Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern Division First Team. Jones finished the 2018-19 season with SU's single-season school record for points (690), a total that ranks fifth in PSAC single-season history. She ranked fourth in the nation in scoring with an average of 25.6 points per game. The PSAC's scoring leader posted double figures in all 27 games she played, including 22 games with 20 or more points and nine games with 30 or more points.
- Forward Aunbrielle Green was named the PSAC Eastern Division Freshman of the Year and selected to the All-PSAC Eastern Division Second Team. Green averaged 12.8 points and 7.0 rebounds in 26 games this season – ranking 20th and 13th respectively in the conference for each category. Overall, Green is the ninth SU player to earn Freshman of the Year honors.
- Shippensburg ranked fourth in the nation last season in free throws made (530) and second in the nation in free-throw attempts (767). Jones led the nation in free throws made (234) and free-throw attempts (297) – both totals that set PSAC single-season records for each category. She averaged 8.7 free throws made per game, and shot 78.8 percent at the free-throw line – a percentage that ranked 11th in the conference.
- Head Coach Kristy Trn ranks among the Top 40 active Division II coaches for career coaching victories. She is a four-time PSAC Divisional Coach of the Year who has guided Shippensburg to six seasons of 20 or more victories while also directing 26 All-PSAC First Team selections in her career.
- Shippensburg's newcomers include a pair of key transfers who started for PSAC East teams last season. All-PSAC First Team junior guard Destiny Jefferson from West Chester and Mansfield's Erin Gibbons.

#6 EAST STROUDSBURG WARRIORS

Quick Hits

- Stephanie Del Preore, who was named ESU's new women's basketball head coach on May 23rd, 2019, enters her first season with the Warriors after spending the previous four at Division I LIU Brooklyn.
- The Warriors return All-PSAC East selections Jordan Hertz and Tiffany Lapotsky for the 2019-20 season. Hertz started all 28 games last season for ESU, while Lapotsky started 27 but appeared in all 28.
- ESU returns four of its primary starters from last season in Hertz, Lapotsky, Dominique Rayam, and Marlene Bassett. Abby Schoffstall, who started 15 games for the Warriors also returns for 2019-20.
- The Warriors added freshman Claire Courter (Allentown, Pa./Parkland) and transfer Kiersten Librizzi from Allegheny College. ESU will also get the services of Sadie Cresswell and Cassie Ksiazek back after both missed last season due to injuries.
- ESU will look to continue its defensive prowess from last season as the Warriors ranked third in the conference in turnover margin (3.25) and forced 19.1 turnovers per contest. ESU also ranked fourth in assist/turnover ratio (.99), second in steals (11.14) and second in assists (15.64).

#7 LOCK HAVEN LADY EAGLES

Quick Hits

- Sharp-shooter Rileigh Devine finished the season with 70 3-pointers. The 70 3's mark the all-time single-season school record. For her career, the junior has 139 made career 3-pointers, which leaves her just three away from tying the all-time school record for made 3's in a career (142).
- When the Bald Eagles won their First Round PSAC Tournament game over ESU, it marked the Bald Eagles first PSAC postseason win in 28 years. Prior to the win, LHU's last playoff win came in 1991.
- One LHU player was named to the 2019 All-PSAC Team. Ahnera Parker was named to the All-PSAC East Second Team after a tremendous season all-around.
- LHU finished the season at 15-14 and the 15 wins served as the most in a single season since the Bald Eagles won 17 during a 17-9 season in 2005-06.
- Early in the season, the Bald Eagles hit a six-game win streak on the way to their 7-1 start. The sensational start led to Lock Haven's first regional ranking in 28 seasons. The six-game win streak marked Lock Haven's longest since a seven-game win streak during the 2005-06 season. The next longest win streak was nine straight wins during the 1989-90 season after Lock Haven opened the season 9-0. The 7-1 start to the season therefore marked the best start to a season since the aforementioned 9-0 start back in 1989-90.

Quick Hits

- The reigning Atlantic Region champions return two starters (seniors Lexi Griggs and Natalie Myers) and seven letterwinners from last year's 30-4 squad.
- Griggs has spent three years in the program with 91 games played and 35 starts. As a first year starter a year ago she averaged 10.9 points and 5.3 rebounds per game with a 57.5 field goal percentage and recorded three double-doubles.
- The Crimson Hawks won the program's sixth PSAC title in 2019, tying Cal U and Shippensburg for the most in conference history.
- IUP has been one of the most successful teams in Division II over the last two seasons with 60 victories, two national semifinalist finishes, two regional championships, a PSAC crown, and two regular season divisional titles.
- The most successful head coach in program history after just six seasons, Tom McConnell as an overall record of 148-38 (.796) with three divisional titles, two conference championships, two regional championships, and back-to-back national semifinalist finishes.

#2 CAL U VULCANS

Quick Hits

- Cal U made its fifth-straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament last season and finished the year ranked No. 21 in the WBCA Top 25 poll. The Vulcans advanced to the regional final of the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in seven years while also posting its fourth 25-win season in the last five years.
- The Vulcans graduated three starters, and their top three scorers, from last season that combined to average over 40 points and 15 rebounds per game. The program will be replacing a WBCA All-American for the third-straight year (Glenn, Parsons, Barrett).
- Cal U led the PSAC and ranked fourth in the country with 13.8 steals per game last year. The Vulcans featured four players ranked among the top 12 in the league in steals and also finished fourth in the nation with a plus-9.09 turnover margin per game.
- Graduate transfer Monica Burns joins the program after sitting out last season. She has scored over 1,000 points in her collegiate career and has been one of the top three-point and free-throw shooters in the country. Burns led NCAA Division II with a .946 free-throw percentage during the 2016-17 campaign while playing at Wheeling.
- The Vulcans will be facing five of the seven other teams that appeared in the NCAA Tournament last season.

#3 EDINBORO FIGHTING SCOTS

Quick Hits

- Former Edinboro standout Callie Wheeler led Edinboro to a 20-9 record in her first season as head coach. An assistant at Edinboro for 11 years, she led Edinboro to a ninth straight 20-win season while making the PSAC Tournament for the 10th straight year. Edinboro received a bid to the NCAA Division II Tournament for the second straight season.
- Michaela Barnes kept Edinboro's tradition of All-Americans alive, earning WBCA honorable mention All-American honors. She was also selected a Women's Division II Bulletin honorable mention All-American, and was recently chosen a Women's Division II Bulletin preseason honorable mention All-American. A 5'6" senior guard, Barnes was also named a first team All-PSAC West honoree and earned second team D2CCA All-Atlantic Region accolades. She averaged a team-leading 21.0 ppg., ranking fourth in the PSAC and 15th in Division II. She was fourth in the PSAC in field goal percentage at 52.1 percent (213-of-409), and led the conference in free throw percentage at 85.7 percent (162-of-189). Barnes scored 609 points in 2018-19, the fourth-highest single-season total. Her 21.0 ppg. scoring average is sixth in a season, while the field goals made (213) is 10th, the free throw percentage (85.7 pct.) is sixth, the free throws made (162) is fourth, and the free throws attempted (189) is sixth. She has moved up to 17th in career scoring with 1,282 points. She set a school-record with 42 points against East Stroudsburg. In addition to standing 17th in career scoring, she will enter her final season ranked third in career free throw percentage at 83.1pct., eighth in free throws made (310), and 12th in free throws attempted (373).
- While Barnes returns, Edinboro must replace two other 1,000-point scorers in Jontay Walton and Ciara Rosten. Walton was a first team All-PSAC West choice, while Rosten earned second team honors. Wheeler looks for a pair of transfers to replace Rosten – 6'3" junior Maggie Gilbert (Southeastern) and 6'2" senior D'Rae Tullock (Arkansas Tech).

Quick Hits

- Cleve Wright enters his 12th season with the Gannon Lady Knights. He returns to begin his second stint with the program after serving four years at the head coach with Miami (Ohio) and two years as associate head coach at Eastern Illinois. Wright is the all-time winningest coach in program history with a 233-100 record with the Knights. He led Gannon to five NCAA Tournament appearances including a Final Four appearance in 2009-10.
